Getting Started

1. Just plugin the device in the office or truck and wait for 2 minutes for the device to start. Then wait approx 3 mins for the first phones to be scanned.
2. The device will connect to phones and ask for permission to send message. Once **Accepted** messages will be sent. After receiving a message it takes **24 hours** before a new request will be sent again.

Setup or Connecting to the Bluetooth Device

1. Plugin the Bluetooth device and connect it VIA a Ethernet cable to the network
2. On a PC on the same network - install and run the WRAP Access EXE program to locate the Bluetooth device. Down and UNZIP from <http://www.sunriseindustries.ie/imgs/wrapfinder.zip>
3. Start the WRAP Access EXE. Then on the WRAP Access EXE press rescan to locate the Bluetooth device's IP address [**not the Broadcast Address**]. It will show something like 192.168.1.10 – IP Address is show far left on the WRAP Access program
4. On the same network as the device - from your PC go to your browser [e.g. Internet Explorer] add that IP address number into the address bar and hit enter.
5. If successful you will see Access Point and all the details of the Bluetooth device. If not go back to the WRAP Access EXE and rescan again to ensure you have the right IP address.
6. Press on Setup on that page and login with the default access details - Username: root / Password: buffy

Adding Content to the Bluetooth Device

1. While in the local web admin go to : Access Point >> Setup >> Applications >> ObexSender
2. In ObexSender --> click on Upload new content file
3. In Upload file >> make sure the file is JPEG, GIF or TXT format and that there is no space in the file name e.g. barcode.gif or marketing-plan.txt. When uploaded hit

Back. If the file uploaded correctly you can see it in Browse content files.

4. Last thing to do is get the Bluetooth device to play the file --> so click on Edit configuration file. In this form area you can set all the details of the playlist etc. All comments are blocked out with the use of a # in front so the make them work all you need to do is remove them. So to get the barcode.gif to load to all people, all you need to do is remove the # for the commands:

```
send {  
file barcode.gif  
}
```

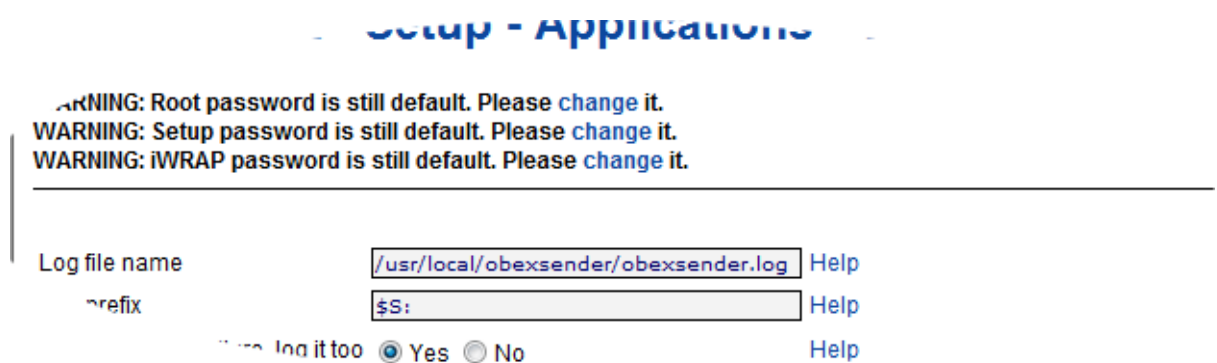
Press Save and hit back button.

5. Last thing is to Restart the Bluetooth device so click on >> Restart ObexSender. If all is ok on the configuration file the device will restart and load the advertisement.

View the Bluetooth Device's Logs

1. In local admin control panel --> Go to Access Point >> Setup >> Applications >> ObexSender >> Log >> View log and click on the day you need to monitor.
2. **IMPORTANT** - In its default configuration, Obexsender's log entries are saved in the syslog file (/var/log/messages and its rotated files). This file is limited to 64KB in size and is saved in the RAM, meaning that **it is reset at any reboot**.

If you need to save logs when transferring from a vehicle to the office, you should configure the log to be saved in some file in the flash memory, for example /usr/local/obexsender/obexsender.log – view the screenshot below:



To do this go into Access Point - Setup - Applications - ObexSender – and Press Log File. On the top of the Log File page you need to edit the field for Log file name. In there add /usr/local/obexsender/obexsender.log and the press save on the bottom of the page.

3. Important to note that if your device has been configured to a Server that all logs will automatically be sent to the server when the device is connected to the Internet. If you find that the logs are empty then contact info@sunriseindustries.ie to get the logs from the server.

Connecting the Bluetooth Device in a Van / Truck



To get the device to work in a van or truck simply purchase a 3 phase plug to 12v car adaptor. These like the one on the left can be purchase in Halfords Store.
